

NEED FOR ASSISTANCE: Guidance for initial estimation



MOBILITY

- The participant (participant) can move independently (approx. 5 km with breaks), independent use of possible aids.

Note: We charge a pushing surcharge of 30% if a participant needs help pushing a wheelchair.

ORIENTATION AND SELF-ORGANIZATION

- After a short introduction and acclimatisation phase, the participant will be able to find his or her own way in a foreign environment (hotel/restaurant/etc.). (He/she finds e.g. the toilet in a restaurant and returns, finds his/her room, the dining room or the lobby in the hotel).
- The participant could also remain alone for a certain time and act self-responsibly.
- The participant can manage his medication himself and takes it on his own at the scheduled time.

BODY CARE AND EXCREMENTS

- The participant is continental, reports urination and stool urgency in time and/or supplies himself with incontinence products on his own.
- The participant carries out personal hygiene independently and with low risk of falling (no supervision necessary).
- The participant dresses himself/herself independently.

FOOD AND BEVERAGES

- The participant eats and drinks on his/her own (possibly after preparation) - no risk of aspiration.

Services key:

- If all questions are answered with “yes”, only the basic price must be paid.
- If a question is answered with “No”, the basic price plus a 20% care surcharge must be paid.
- If two questions are answered with “No”, the basic price plus a 30% care surcharge must be paid.
- If three questions are answered with “No”, the basic price plus a 40% care surcharge must be paid.
- If four questions are answered with “No”, the care surcharge is 40-80%. This requires a more detailed assessment by our team.
